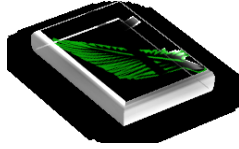

March 17, "Barabbas the Murderer"

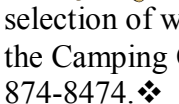
